



## ***Neighborhood Alert!!!***

***Proposed road extension threatens  
Flower Mound Quality Of Life.***

***P&Z will vote on December 8th, 2008***

On Monday night, December 8<sup>th</sup>, 2008, the Town of Flower Mound Planning and Zoning Commission will **VOTE** to add the **West Windsor Extension** connecting **FM 2499** to **W. Windsor Drive** (as an alternative to FM 1171) to the Master Transportation Plan (see below for details). Currently, this connection is not a part of any future development plan. However, if approved, it will directly affect the communities of Westchester, Pecan Acres, Bridlewood, and Glenwick by disturbing the **safety, security, lifestyle, property values, and community appeal in these neighborhoods.**

## ***Recent History***

In 1999, Town Council removed the Windsor Extension from the Master Plan due to public opposition. In 2003, Kimley Horn—Flower Mound's traffic consultant - recommended adding the extension back into the Master Plan (named Eaton Extension at the time) and provided an estimated traffic increase of 12,000 cars per day on the proposed road, according to the December 2002 memo to Town Council. Again, due to overwhelming opposition demonstrated by the large numbers of citizens at the P&ZC and the Town Council meetings, of the Town of Flower Mound voted once again to leave the extension off of the Master Plan.

## ***Reasons why residents oppose this thoroughfare:***

- **Safety!** Increased traffic can jeopardize the safety of children and pedestrians currently using W. Windsor Drive as their route to and from school, the golf club, pool, and walking/bike trails.
- **Security!** An unnecessary thoroughfare constructed through our neighborhoods, bringing along with it non-resident cars and strangers, can jeopardize the security of the entire community.
- **Congestion!** While FM 1171 is under construction, W. Windsor could be an alternate route, if the thoroughfare is permitted. Imagine up to **4,500 new cars/day** rushing through the neighborhood, especially at rush hour. W. Windsor, Glenwick Blvd., and the entire route along Bridlewood Boulevard will become a traffic hazard for all residents making their way out of side streets onto these two main streets and through school zones at Bridlewood Boulevard and W. Windsor Drive.
